## RULES

### ROSTER:

- Each team must submit a roster with a maximum of 15 players. No player may register with more than 1 team.
- Tournament is open to alumni, their spouses, their children, their siblings and their parents! Each team may have up to 6 Non-Alumni Players.
- \$300.00 Entrance Fee per team. A 50% deposit (\$150.00) must be paid no later than Tuesday, November 29th to be scheduled to play in this tournament.
- Deadline to register a team is Tuesday, November 29th, 2016.
- A player must be on the roster and must have signed the waiver form to play in this tournament. Parent and/or legal guardian must sign waiver form for any minor participating in this tournament.

### GAMES:

- Teams will be placed in pools. Each team will play all teams in their pools.
- 1 set to 30 using the rally point system, cap at 33; or 30 minute time limit, (whichever comes first) counting as a win or loss.
- After pool play, each teams' standings will determine their placement in playoff games.
- Team will consist of 1~3 males and/or 1~6 females on the court at any given time, of the 6 players, no more than 3 non-alumni players.
- It's acceptable to play with 5 people with a minimum of 3 females; however, when the sixth person is up to serve, the team loses the serve. Ghost player is considered the sixth player on the court and shall represent the sixth position on the rotation chart.
- Unlimited substitutions.
- Males are only allowed to attack the ball from behind the ten foot line.
- When the ball is played more than once by a team, a female player shall make at least one of the contacts. Contact by two male players with ball going over the net will be ruled an illegal contact and a point will be awarded to the other team.
- No blocking or spiking the serve.
- A player may not play in playoffs unless he or she has participated in at least one pool play set.
- Net serves will be played.

- All players must rotate positions.
- Height of the net for this tournament is 7' 7".
- Game time is forfeited on the 1<sup>st</sup> set
- 10 minute grace period will be given to the team forfeiting the first set. If the 10 minute period has elapsed and the team is still not complete, the second set will be forfeited.
- Teams that forfeit 3 or more games may not participate in the playoffs.
- If there is a tie in standings at the end of pool play, placement for playoffs will be determined by point spread.

### **PLAYOFFS:**

- Games will be played 2 out of 3 games.
- Each set to 25, must win by two. 3<sup>rd</sup> set to 15, must win by two.
- The number of teams that advance to playoffs will be determined by head-to-head, then by points allowed (if needed).
- Single elimination.

### **WORK TEAMS:**

- After each match, each team is required to provide three players to the work team for the following match. They will act as referees, scorekeepers and/or ball retrievers.
- Please provide players who are familiar with the rules and who are dependable.
