



BLESSED THERESA GERHARDINGER SCHOLARSHIP SY 2022 – 2023

The Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Scholarship is a yearly scholarship program for rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors of Notre Dame High School who have demonstrated an enduring commitment to school and community service. Criteria for this scholarship includes maintaining active involvement in the school's Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Club for SY 2022-2023 and the wider community, and maintaining a quarterly grade point average of 85% with Satisfactory/Excellent citizenship. Recipient receives \$475-\$850 based on criteria met and goes towards monthly tuition only.

Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible for the Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Scholarship, the Notre Dame student must:

- be a returning sophomore, junior, or senior.
- have a cumulative grade point average of 85% or higher with a Satisfactory or Excellent Citizenship grade.
- be involved in extracurricular and service-related activities at Notre Dame High School and in the community. (Membership in the school's Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Club will be a requirement beginning school year 2023-2024)
- Please note, current merit and athletic scholarship recipient students, and students receiving financial aid are not eligible to apply for the Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Scholarship.

How to Apply for the Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Scholarship

1. Enroll as a Notre Dame student.
2. Submit the following information and documentation to the Business Office by **Monday, June 20 by 3:00 p.m.**
 - Submit **two short essays** (approximately 500 words each) - addressing the following prompts:
 - Essay 1: Notre Dame High School provides a serene learning environment for development of the whole person. Notre Dame High School “encourages collaboration, instills leadership, promotes dedication to service, and inspires passion for justice and peace in the spirit of Jesus Christ. **How do you strive**



to embody the mission of Notre Dame High School?

- Essay 2: You have been educated with the Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger Curriculum by your Theology teachers since you became a student of Notre Dame High School. Keep in mind all that you have learned about her life and her charism to “transform the world through education” when writing an essay for this prompt. Choose one of Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger’s quotes below and explain what it means to you. Share your community and/or volunteer experience(s) and how it connects with the Blessed Theresa Gerhardinger’s quote that you chose.
 - *With the Lord what we do is less important than how we do it.*
 - *When I teach others what I must instruct them in, I will have to first learn and practice myself.*
 - *United and content with little, we go out into the whole world, into the tiniest villages, into the poorest dwellings, wherever the Lord calls us, to bring poor children the good news of God’s kingdom.*
 - *The candle consumes itself as it serves others by its shining.*
- *Resumé of high school and community activities*, identifying up to 10 extracurricular, service activities, or work experiences that best represent you. Please include: Organization name, dates of involvement, positions held, description of activity. This document should be in a resume format and information can be presented as bullet-points.
- *Two letters of recommendation*
 - one letter of recommendation from a current teacher
 - one letter of recommendation from a supervisor of one of your listed activities
