**TEMPORARY ADDENDUM**

During the IYAAG High School monthly board meeting, a recommendation was made to modify the current Rules and Regulations pertaining to Medical Forms requirements for student participation. Specifically, this would affect Section 4.6, Subsection 4.6.2 wherein "Medical clearance certifications expire at the end of one (1) calendar year or when revoked by a doctor and/or parent/guardian".

Due to the COVID-19 situation and subsequent suspension of organized sports activities, including any interscholastic sports for over 6 months, the physical wellness of students who wish to practice and compete in interscholastic activities should be re-evaluated by a medical doctor before returning to sports this school year. As such, the IYAAG board members agree to a Temporary Addendum of the standing Rule IV, Section 4.6, Subsection 4.6.2, as follows:

***Section 4.6 PARENT CONSENT/MEDICAL FORMS/HOLD HARMLESS FORM***

**4.6.2 (A) (Insert Addendum)**

Before participating in any practice and/or interscholastic sports event, a Student must present a Physical Examination certification signed by a medical doctor, dated no earlier than April 1, 2020, indicating that the student is physically able to participate in interscholastic sports activities.

This Rule will remain in effect until the IYAAG Board votes to remove the Addendum. This Addendum does not affect nor change any other Rules & Regulations of the IYAAG and is added as a precaution for the safety and welfare of the students.
